



Table Notes:

- Use CEEM Excel program to assist in determining advanced Standing status.
- An additional tuition fee is required with TAS/PAS as approved by AzBOR
- For borderline case, student must see advisor at end of current semester when new grades are available for early decision on PAS or adjust remedial.
- Remedial semester, if needed, begins with the semester after TAS is first used for CASES 1, 3, 4, and the first TAS semester for CASES 2, 5.

Recommended Remedial Steps for GPA < 2.25 on CE LDC Courses

- GPA < 2.0: But overall UAGPA > 2.0, follow steps for GPA 2.0-2.1 given below
- GPA 2.0-2.1: Retake/GRO a semester of fundamental coursework
- GPA 2.1-2.2: Retake/GRO one fundamental course along with 300 level coursework (TAS)
- GPA 2.2-2.25: Proceed to 300 level classes with TAS.

These are guidelines and are ultimately up to the judgment of the student's academic advisor. However, it should be approved by the CEEM UCSC, if any remedial steps are taken beyond the recommendations made here
